

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY


Despite two years of public health orders restricting our ability to meet face-to-face, including to conduct in-person research, staff at Cairnmillar have been working to maintain their research productivity. Staff have published 20 papers in peer-reviewed journals, and of the 20 with Impact Factor scores (Clarivate Journal Citation Reports), the average IF is an astounding 4.57. Under the broad heading of "PSYCHOLOGY" an impact factor of 3.52 was the boundary between Q1 and Q2 journals. Twelve of our papers exceeded this threshold. Five papers were the results of collaborations by academics within Cairnmillar Institute. Beyond journal articles, our staff authored 2 book chapters and presented 28 research papers at national and international conferences. Finally, one of our own, Sasha Davies, successfully completed and passed her PhD thesis.
