EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Research at Cairnmillar has continued to rebound following the difficult years of pandemic lockdown. Staff have published 37 papers in peer-reviewed journals, and of the 28 with Impact Factor (IF) scores (Clarivate Journal Citation Reports), the average IF is 3.72. Two thirds of these indexed publications were published in Q1 and Q2 ranked journals. Beyond journal articles, our staff authored one book and four book chapters, and presented 13 research papers at national and international conferences. Cairnmillar staff hold memberships on the editorial boards of five academic journals, one staff member was the Scientific Convenor of a national research conference, and one staff member was a co-investigator on a successful grant application.
